Geoffrey Wilson (21st May 1924 – 21st August 2023)

Geoffrey joined the RAF Volunteer Regiment aged 16 which is where he fell in love with MG VA (408) AHS 87. Its owner became a friend and later a Spitfire pilot and was killed early on in the war. Aged 17, Geoffrey joined Bomber Command and was shot in the arms and leg while navigating a Lancaster Bomber, targeting the bridges over the Rhine in Dusseldorf. The injuries put him out of the War.

Geoffrey married in 1951 and bought the VA from his friend's widow. It had been chocked up in a wooden garage for the previous 10 years or so. He drove it home on the same tank of petrol! Following the war he became a woodwork and metalwork teacher, but also taught car mechanics. As a couple, they enjoyed camping and caravanning in Scotland. In 1952 he fitted a homemade tow bar to the VA and it was used as a family car until 1965. It was refurbished in 1992 by Peter Ratcliffe.

Geoff enjoyed going to rallies and events, particularly the annual SVW gatherings. Ownership of the VA passed to his son Nigel in 2006 and they both continued to attend these events for many of the following years. Our sincere condolences were sent to Nigel and Valerie and the extended family.
